Certain versions of [Dolibarr](#) from [Dolibarr](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Dolibarr ERP/CRM before 10.0.3 allows XSS because uploaded HTML documents are served as text/html despite being renamed to .noexe files.

CVE-2019-19210 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
