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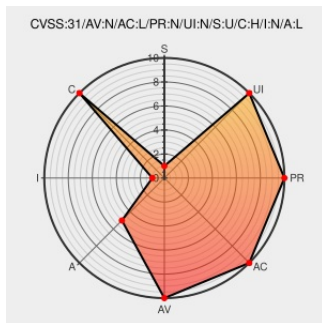

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Certain versions of [Ansible Tower](#) from [Redhat](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A flaw was found in Ansible Tower, versions 3.6.x before 3.6.2 and 3.5.x before 3.5.3, where enabling RabbitMQ manager by setting it with '-e rabbitmq_enable_manager=true' exposes the RabbitMQ management interface publicly, as expected. If the default admin user is still active, an attacker could guess the password and gain access to

the system.

CVE-2019-19340 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
