

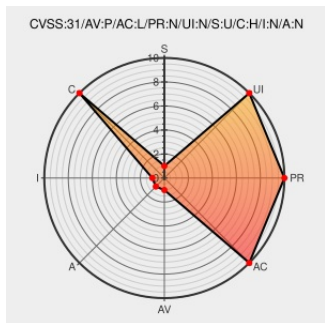

Certain versions of [Debian Linux](#) from [Debian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In the Linux kernel before 5.2.9, there is an info-leak bug that can be caused by a malicious USB device in the `drivers/net/can/usb/peak_usb/pcan_usb_pro.c` driver, aka CID-ead16e53c2f0.

CVE-2019-19536 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
