Description	An issue was discovered in Big Switch Big Monitoring Fabric 6.2 through 6.2.4, 6.3 through 6.3.9, 7.0 through 7.0.3, and 7.0.4 through 7.0.5. The issue is a denial of service vulnerability that can be exploited by sending a specially crafted request to the application. The request contains a large number of 'X' characters, which causes the application to crash. The vulnerability is located in the 'Big Monitoring Fabric' component of the 'Big Switch' product.
