

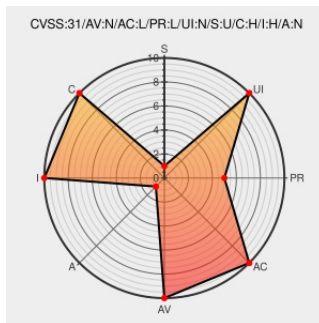

Certain versions of [Itop](#) from [Combodo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A post-authentication privilege escalation in the web application of Combodo iTop allows regular authenticated users to access information and modify information with administrative privileges by not following the HTTP Location header in server responses. This is fixed in all iTop packages (community, essential, professional) in versions :

2.5.4, 2.6.3, 2.7.0

CVE-2019-19821 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
