Certain versions of [Serpico](#) from [Serpico Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Serpico (aka Simple RePort wrtling and CollaboratiOn tool) 1.3.0. It does not use CSRF Tokens to mitigate against CSRF; it uses the Origin header (which must match the request origin). This is problematic in conjunction with XSS: one can escalate privileges from User level to Administrator.

CVE-2019-19854 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
