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Certain versions of [Mediawiki](#) from [Mediawiki](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The MinervaNeue Skin in MediaWiki from 2019-11-05 to 2019-12-13 (1.35 and/or 1.34) mishandles certain HTML attributes, as demonstrated by `IMG onmouseover=` (impact is XSS) and `IMG src=http` (impact is disclosing the client's IP address). This can occur within a talk page topical header that is viewed within a mobile

(MobileFrontend) context.

CVE-2019-19910 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
