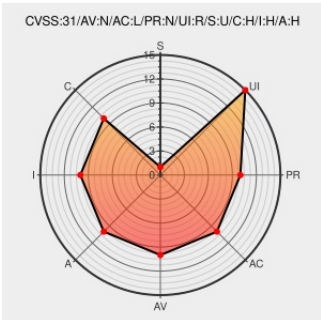

Certain versions of [Gila Cms](#) from [Gilacms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Gila CMS before 1.11.6 allows CSRF with resultant XSS via the admin/themes URI, leading to compromise of the admin account.

CVE-2019-20804 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
