

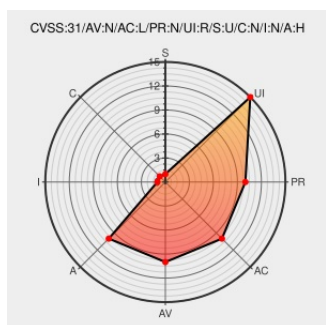

Certain versions of [Libredwg](#) from [Gnu](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in GNU LibreDWG through 0.9.3. Crafted input will lead to denial of service in bit_calc_CRC in bits.c, related to a for loop.

CVE-2019-20911 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
