

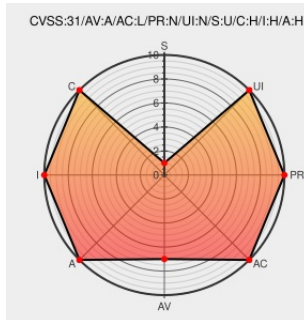

Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

When pairing with a Bluetooth device, it may be possible to pair a malicious device without any confirmation from the user, and that device may be able to interact with the phone. This could lead to remote escalation of privilege with no additional execution privileges needed. User interaction is not needed for exploitation. Product:
