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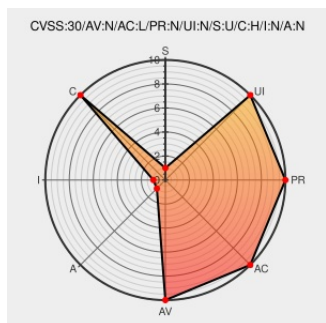

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Certain versions of [Food And Beverage Applications](#) from [Oracle](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Vulnerability in the Oracle Hospitality Symphony component of Oracle Food and Beverage Applications. The supported version that is affected is 18.2.1. Easily exploitable vulnerability allows unauthenticated attacker with network access via HTTP to compromise Oracle Hospitality Symphony. Successful attacks of this vulnerability can result in unauthorized access to critical data or complete access to all Oracle Hospitality Symphony accessible data. CVSS 3.0 Base Score 7.5 (Confidentiality impacts). CVSS Vector: (CVSS:3.0/AV:N/AC:L/PR:N/UI:N/S:U/C:H/I:N/A:N).

CVE-2019-2836 has been assigned by secalert_us@oracle.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
