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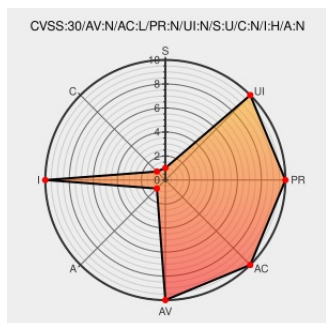
CVE-2019-2838

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Certain versions of [Solaris](#) from [Oracle](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Vulnerability in the Oracle Solaris component of Oracle Sun Systems Products Suite (subcomponent: Kernel). The supported version that is affected is 11.4. Easily exploitable vulnerability allows unauthenticated attacker with network access via NFS to compromise Oracle Solaris.

Successful attacks of this vulnerability can result in unauthorized creation, deletion or modification access to critical data or all Oracle Solaris accessible data. CVSS 3.0 Base Score 7.5 (Integrity impacts). CVSS Vector: (CVSS:3.0/AV:N/AC:L/PR:N/UI:N/S:U/C:N/I:H/A:N).

CVE-2019-2838 has been assigned by [secalert_us@oracle.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
