Certain versions of [Inxedu](#) from [Inxedu Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

inxedu through 2018-12-24 has a SQL Injection vulnerability that can lead to information disclosure via the deleteFavorite/ PATH_INFO. The vulnerable code location is com.inxedu.os.edu.controller.user.UserController#deleteFavorite (aka deleteFavorite in

com/inxedu/os/edu/controller/user/UserController.java), where courseFavoritesService.deleteCourseFavoritesById is mishandled during use of MyBatis. NOTE: UserController.java has a spelling variation in an annotation: a @RequestMapping("/deleteFaveorite/{ids}") line followed by a "public ModelAndView deleteFavorite" line.

CVE-2019-3576 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
