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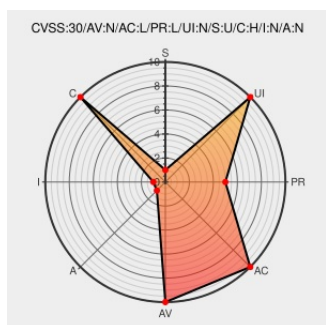

Certain versions of [Openemr](#) from [Open-emr](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In OpenEMR 5.0.1 and earlier, the patient file download interface contains a directory traversal flaw that allows authenticated attackers to download arbitrary files from the host system.

CVE-2019-3967 has been assigned by vulnreport@tenable.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
