Certain versions of **Pfc200** from **Wago** contain the following vulnerability:

An exploitable stack buffer overflow vulnerability exists in the iocheckd service 'I/O-Check' functionality of WAGO PFC 200 Firmware version 03.02.02(14). An attacker can send a specially crafted packet to trigger the parsing of this cache file. The destination buffer sp+0x440 is overflowed with the call to sprintf() for any ip values that are greater than 1024-len('/etc/config-tools/config_interfaces interface=X1 state=enabled ip-address=') in length. A ip value of length 0x3da will cause the service to crash.

CVE-2019-5180 has been assigned by [talos-cna@cisco.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
