

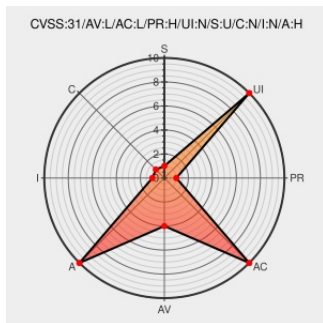

Certain versions of [Virtual Gpu Manager](#) from [Nvidia](#) contain the following vulnerability:

NVIDIA Virtual GPU Manager, all versions, contains a vulnerability in the vGPU plugin, in which an input index value is incorrectly validated, which may lead to denial of service.

CVE-2019-5698 has been assigned by psirt@nvidia.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
