

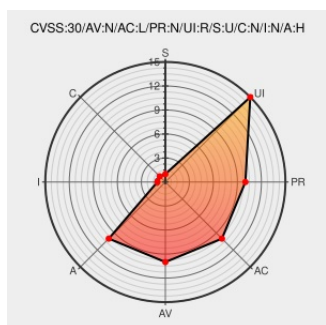

Certain versions of [Chrome](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Incorrect handling of deferred code in V8 in Google Chrome prior to 72.0.3626.96 allowed a remote attacker to potentially exploit heap corruption via a crafted HTML page.

CVE-2019-5784 has been assigned by [Google](#) security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
