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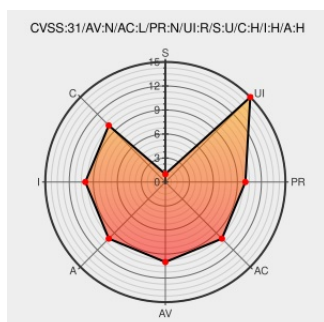

Certain versions of [Debian Linux](#) from [Debian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Parameter passing error in media in Google Chrome prior to 74.0.3729.131 allowed a remote attacker to potentially exploit heap corruption via a crafted HTML page.

CVE-2019-5824 has been assigned by security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
