

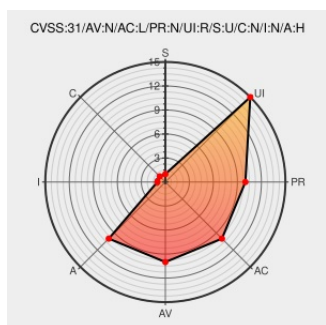

Certain versions of [Chrome](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Out of bounds access in SwiftShader in Google Chrome prior to 73.0.3683.75 allowed a remote attacker to potentially exploit heap corruption via a crafted HTML page.

CVE-2019-5846 has been assigned by [Google](#) security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
