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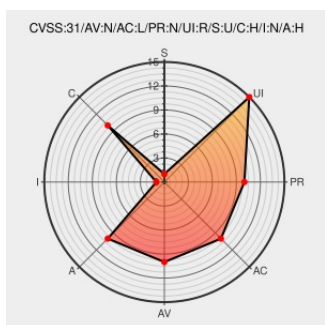

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Certain versions of [Chrome](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Out of bounds read in Skia in Google Chrome prior to 75.0.3770.80 allowed a remote attacker to obtain potentially sensitive information from process memory via a crafted HTML page.

CVE-2019-5849 has been assigned by [Google](#) security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
