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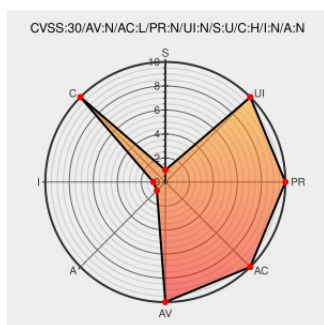

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Certain versions of **Insurance Wallet** from **Ichain** contain the following vulnerability:

Directory traversal vulnerability in iChain Insurance Wallet App for iOS Version 1.3.0 and earlier allows remote attackers to read arbitrary files via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2019-5923 has been assigned by vultures@jpcert.or.jp to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
