

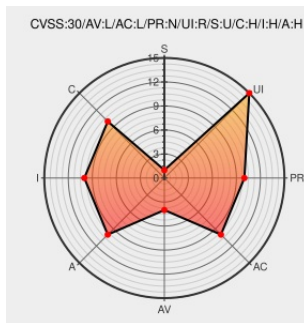

Certain versions of [Electronic Reception And Examination Of Application For Radio Licenses](#) from [Soumu](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Untrusted search path vulnerability in Installer of Electronic reception and examination of application for radio licenses Online 1.0.9.0 and earlier allows an attacker to gain privileges via a Trojan horse DLL in an unspecified directory.

CVE-2019-5957 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
