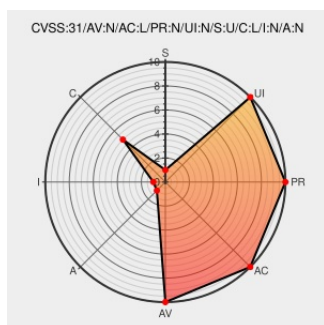

Certain versions of **Payment Module** from **Remise** contain the following vulnerability:

REMISE Payment Module (2.11, 2.12 and 2.13) version 3.0.12 and earlier allow remote attackers to [Disclosed_Information_type] via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2019-6017 has been assigned by vultures@jpcert.or.jp to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
