

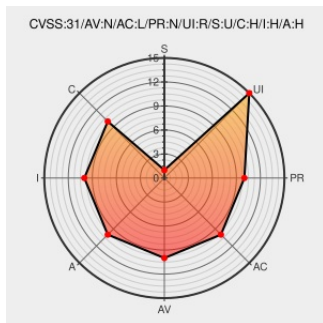

Certain versions of [Wpspellcheck](#) from [Wpspellcheck](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in WP Spell Check 7.1.9 and earlier allows remote attackers to hijack the authentication of administrators via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2019-6027 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
