

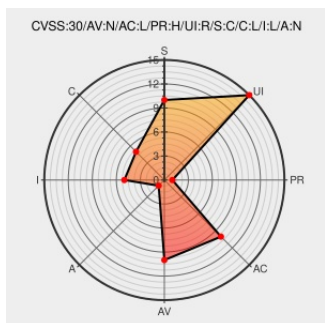

Certain versions of [Centos Web Panel](#) from [Centos-webpanel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CentOS-WebPanel.com (aka CWP) CentOS Web Panel through 0.9.8.763 is vulnerable to Stored/Persistent XSS for the "Package Name" field via the add_package module parameter.

CVE-2019-7646 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
