

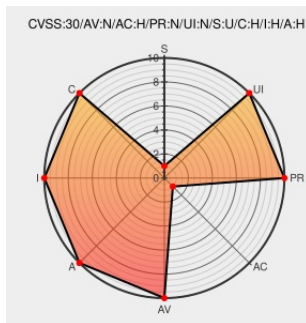

Certain versions of [Metinfo](#) from [Metinfo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Metinfo 6.x. An attacker can leverage a race condition in the backend database backup function to execute arbitrary PHP code via admin/index.php?

n=databack&c=index&a=dogetsql&tables=<?php and admin/databack/bakup_tables.php?2=file_put_contents URIs because app/system/databack/admin/index.class.php creates bakup_tables.php temporarily.

CVE-2019-7718 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
