Description	Adobe Campaign Classic version 18.10.5-8984 and earlier versions have an Information Exposure Through an Error Message Vulnerability. An attacker can exploit this vulnerability to cause an information disclosure. The vulnerability is caused by a lack of input validation in the error handling logic. An attacker can exploit this vulnerability by sending a specially crafted request to the application. The attacker can then cause the application to display an error message that contains sensitive information. This information can be used to gain further access to the application or to cause other damage.
