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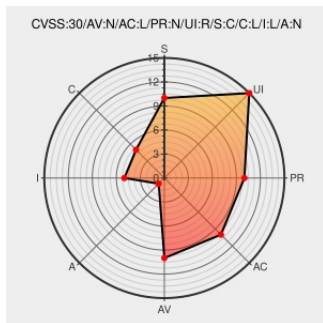

Adobe Experience Manager version 6.4 and earlier have a Stored Cross-site Scripting vulnerability. Successful exploitation could lead to Sensitive Information disclosure in the context of the current user.
