

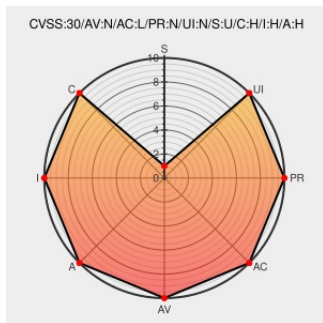

Certain versions of [Experience Manager](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Experience Manager versions 6.5, and 6.4 have an authentication bypass vulnerability. Successful exploitation could lead to remote code execution.

CVE-2019-7964 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Adobe - Adobe Experience Manager** version **6.5, and 6.4 versions**

CVSS3 Score: **9.8 - CRITICAL**
