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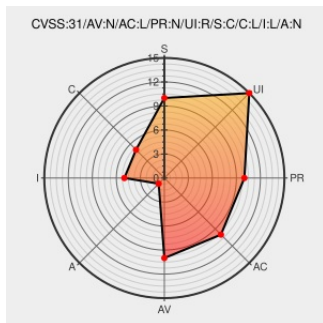

Adobe Experience Manager versions 6.4, 6.3, 6.2, 6.1, and 6.0 have a stored cross site scripting vulnerability. Successful exploitation could lead to sensitive information disclosure.

CVE-2019-8079 has been assigned by [psirt@adobe.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
