

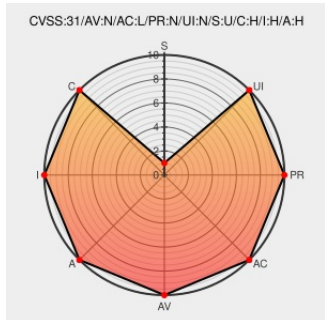

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## CVE-2019-9165

Certain versions of [Nagios Xi](#) from [Nagios](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in Nagios XI before 5.5.11 allows attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the API when using fusekeys and malicious user id.

CVE-2019-9165 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
