Certain versions of [Eloan](#) from [Eloan Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Eloan V3.0 through 2018-09-20 allows remote attackers to list files via a direct request to the p2p/api/ or p2p/lib/ or p2p/images/ URI.

CVE-2019-9552 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
