

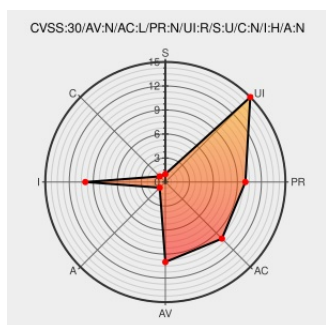

Certain versions of [Cscms](#) from [Chshcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Cscms 4.1.0. There is an admin.php/pay CSRF vulnerability that can change the payment account to redirect funds.

CVE-2019-9598 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
