

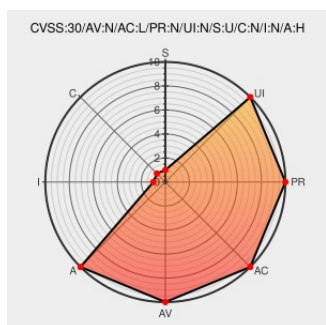

Certain versions of [Airdrop](#) from [Airdrop Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The AirDrop application through 2.0 for Android allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service via a client that makes many socket connections through a configured port.

CVE-2019-9832 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
