

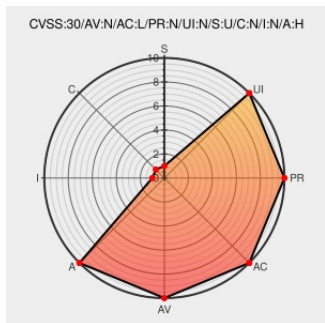

Certain versions of [Screen Stream](#) from [Screen Stream Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Screen Stream application through 3.0.15 for Android allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service via many simultaneous /start-stop requests.

CVE-2019-9833 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
