

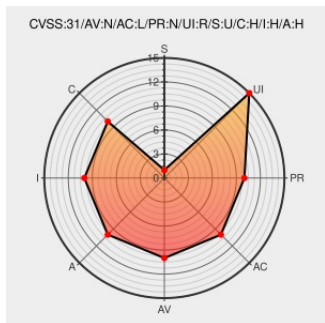

Certain versions of [Labkey Server](#) from [Labkey](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in LabKey Server 19.1.0. It is possible to force a logged-in administrator to execute code through a `/reports-viewScriptReport.view` CSRF vulnerability.

CVE-2019-9926 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
