

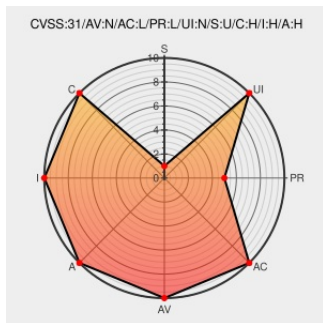

Certain versions of [Vtenext](#) from [Vtenext](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A file upload vulnerability in vtecrm vtenext 19 CE allows authenticated users to upload files with a .pht extension, resulting in remote code execution.

CVE-2020-10228 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
