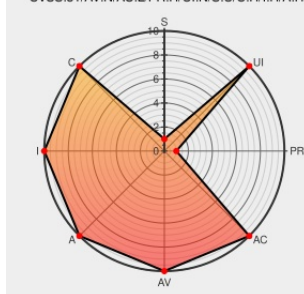

Certain versions of [Laravel-administrator](#) from [Frozennode](#) contain the following vulnerability:

FrozenNode Laravel-Administrator through 5.0.12 allows unrestricted file upload (and consequently Remote Code Execution) via admin/tips\_image/image/file\_upload image upload with PHP content within a GIF image that has the .php extension. NOTE: this product is discontinued.

CVE-2020-10963 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
