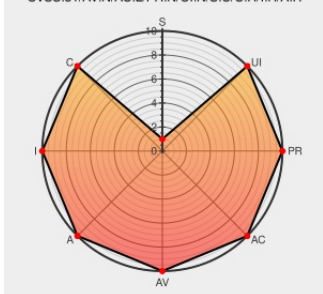

Azkaban through 3.84.0 allows XXE, related to validator/XmlValidatorManager.java and user/XmlUserManager.java.

CVE-2020-10992 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
