

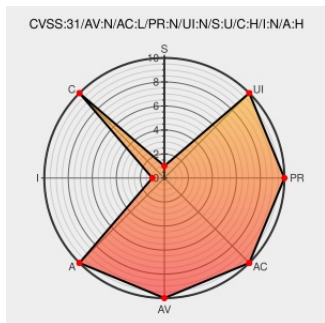

Certain versions of [Osmand](#) from [Osmand](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Osmand through 2.0.0 allow XXE because of binary/BinaryMapIndexReader.java.

CVE-2020-10993 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
