Certain versions of [Secure Enterprise Client](#) from [Ncp-e](#) contain the following vulnerability:

NCP Secure Enterprise Client before 10.15 r47589 allows a symbolic link attack on enumusb.reg via Support Assistant.

CVE-2020-11474 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
