Certain versions of [Learnpress](#) from [Thimpress](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The LearnPress plugin before 3.2.6.9 for WordPress allows remote attackers to escalate the privileges of any user to LP Instructor via the accept-to-be-teacher action parameter.

CVE-2020-11511 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
