

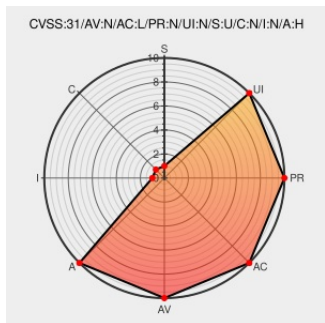

Certain versions of [Youtrack](#) from [Jetbrains](#) contain the following vulnerability:

JetBrains YouTrack before 2020.1.659 was vulnerable to DoS that could be caused by attaching a malformed TIFF file to an issue.

CVE-2020-11693 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
