Certain versions of [Dungeon Crawl Stone Soup](#) from [Dungeon Crawl Stone Soup Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Dungeon Crawl Stone Soup (aka DCSS or crawl) before 0.25 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via Lua bytecode embedded in an uploaded .crawlrc file.

CVE-2020-11722 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
