

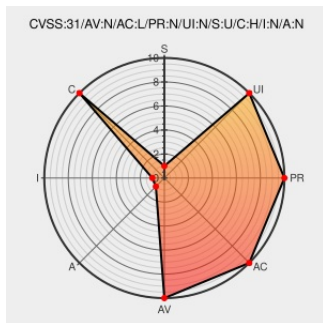

Certain versions of [Micollab Audio Web Video Conferencing](#) from [Mitel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An Authentication Bypass vulnerability in the Published Area of the web conferencing component of Mitel MiCollab AWW before 8.1.2.4 and 9.x before 9.1.3 could allow an unauthenticated attacker to gain access to unauthorized information due to insufficient access validation. A successful exploit could allow an attacker to access

sensitive shared files.

CVE-2020-11797 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
