Certain versions of [Unomi](#) from [Apache](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Apache Unomi allows conditions to use OGNL scripting which offers the possibility to call static Java classes from the JDK that could execute code with the permission level of the running Java process.

CVE-2020-11975 has been assigned by security@apache.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
