

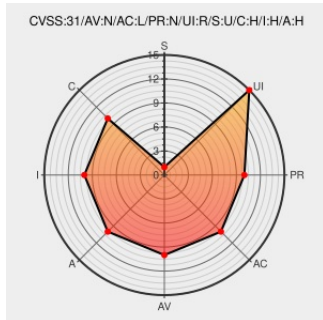

Certain versions of **365 Apps** from **Microsoft** contain the following vulnerability:

A remote code execution vulnerability exists in Microsoft Excel software when the software fails to properly handle objects in memory, aka 'Microsoft Excel Remote Code Execution Vulnerability'.

CVE-2020-1240 has been assigned by secure@microsoft.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
