Certain versions of [Avalanche](#) from [Ivanti](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Ivanti Avalanche 6.3 allows a SQL injection that is vaguely associated with the Apache HTTP Server, aka Bug 683250.

CVE-2020-12442 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
