Certain versions of [Serpico](#) from [Serpico Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Serpico before 1.3.3. The `/admin/attachments_backup` endpoint can be requested by non-admin authenticated users. This means that an attacker with a user account can retrieve all of the attachments of all users (including administrators) from the database.

CVE-2020-12687 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
