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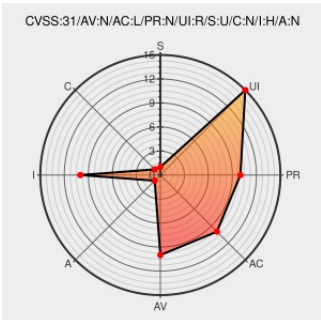

Certain versions of [Nukeviet](#) from [Nukeviet](#) contain the following vulnerability:

modules\users\admin\edit.php in NukeViet 4.4 allows CSRF to change a user's password via an admin/index.php?nv=users&op=edit&userid=URI. The old password is not needed.

CVE-2020-13157 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
